THE BODY IN PRAYER AND WORSHIP

In this series we will explore physical presence and movement in worship. While the sessions will be primarily experiential, we will examine the topic intellectually as well. Reflecting on how the body has been used and understood in the Bible and in the history of Christianity will provide a context for a practice of embodied prayer. Our practice will include postures of the body as prayer, and sequences of postures to prayer songs, and sitting in stillness.

We will draw upon the depth of understanding offered by the ancient tradition of yoga as a devotional practice and as a means of releasing the restlessness of the body to prepare the mind to be still that it may hear the voice of God, whether in silent meditation or quiet scripture reading. These practices call us to integrate body, mind, and spirit in our worship.

All poses and sequences can be modified for all conditions, abilities, and propensities. Chairs will be provided for those uncomfortable on the floor. Mats and blankets also provided. Wear clothing in which you can move easily. Yoga is best on an empty or nearly empty stomach.
